Our expectations

You should be an open-minded person and like to have contact to different people from different countries. You also should be interested in learning German through the contact with native speakers and are open to get to know new places, new projects and new forms of passing spare/ leisure time.

What to earn?

The work is payed, but it is kind of a donation and depends on what you do. More value has the contact to the people, the getting-together with different organizations in the city, which offer a big spectra of money-free activities.

In an informal talk we explain you everything in detail (German, English, Arabic).

Some conditions

The AGH ist only for people who are not jet listed in the "Jobcenter". Here we are looking for two guides, who work more or less 15 hours per week. You invite people of your "camp" to get to know the social and cultural free offers in the city and go with them there. Here you get around 80 Euros per month and a lot of contact to cool spaces and people. **Some German would be nice, but is for the work not obligatory.**

The volunteers for translation need to talk some German of course. As a language guide you help to translate some socio-cultural information and help with the communication between German volunteers and refugees. This can be payed per hour.
